
Feedback










Children's Day: Visiting Chitrari Asha School (School for Children with Special Needs

The students returned from the school with hearts filled with joy and love.


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CHM Centre Visit


Impact:


Student Teachers nurture creativity, innovativeness, intellectual and thinking skills, empathy, life skills etc. among students through the Teaching learning process.
