
NATIONAL PRIORITY PROGRAMMES 2024-25




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INTERNATIONAL DAY OF ERADICATION POVERTY 17-10-2024


- 1. Salafi English Medium School, Village Mukk

NATIONAL MILK DAY 26-11-2024








REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATIONS 26-01-2025
